This year, December 13 marks California's first "Day of the Horse" thanks to the efforts of Dennis Reis, founder of the School of Universal Horsemanship in Penngrove, Calif. With help from Assemblyman Joe Nation the proposed Day of the Horse, to be celebrated the second Saturday in December, passed unanimously on the senate floor in June 2002. Dennis is now working to create a national Day of the Horse.
